

- You can handle your citation through the mail or in person at 16628 San Luis Pass Road in Jamaica Beach, Texas. Defendants 16 years of age or younger must attend court, accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, on the appearance date shown on the citation. In the event of an alcohol related offense, defendants 17 years of age or younger must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- You may be eligible to attend a driving safety course or motorcycle operator training course for dismissal of your citation if:
- you were cited for a moving violation and, if you were speeding, it was no more than 24 miles per hour over the speed limit.
  - you have not attended such a course for the purpose of ticket dismissal within the past year.
  - you have a valid Texas Driver's License and proof of motor vehicle insurance in effect when the citation was issued.
- You must present to the court, by the appearance date on your citation, a written request to attend a driving safety course or a motorcycle operator training course. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of your right to take the course for ticket dismissal.*
- **A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION OF AN OFFENSE UNDER THE TEXAS MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY RESPONSIBILITY ACT WILL RESULT IN THE SUSPENSION OF YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE AND MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION UNLESS YOU FILE AND MAINTAIN EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE OF CONVICTION. THE DEPARTMENT MAY WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT TO FILE EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY IF YOU FILE SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE WITH THE DEPARTMENT SHOWING THAT AT THE TIME THIS CITATION WAS ISSUED, THE VEHICLE WAS COVERED BY A MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY OR THAT YOU WERE OTHERWISE EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS TO PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY.**
- **CONVICTION OF AN OFFENSE UNDER A TRAFFIC LAW OF THIS STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE MAY RESULT IN THE ASSESSMENT ON YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE OF A SURCHARGE UNDER THE DRIVER RESPONSIBILITY PROGRAM.**

CHECK ONE OF THE FOUR OPTIONS AND SIGN BELOW. CALL THE COURT FOR THE AMOUNT DUE (IF APPLICABLE TO YOUR SELECTION.) SUBMIT THIS FORM TO THE COURT.

- I am over 16 years of age and waive my right to a trial and to be represented by an attorney. I hereby enter a plea of  Guilty or  Nolo Contendere and will pay the fine due.
- I hereby enter a plea of  Guilty or  Nolo Contendere, waive my right to a trial, and enter a motion for a  driving safety course  motorcycle operator training course. (This option not available for those with a commercial driver's license. Also, some charges, including speeding 25 m.p.h. or more over the posted limit, are not eligible for dismissal by taking a driving safety course or motorcycle operator training course.)
- I hereby enter a plea of  Guilty or  Nolo Contendere and request that I be considered for Deferred Disposition, which is a form of probation. I understand that if I pay a deferral fee, and I do not violate any conditions of the probation, the charge will be dismissed and no record of conviction will result. (This option not available for those with a commercial driver's license. Certain restrictions apply to drivers under the age of 25. Call the court office for details.)
- I hereby enter a plea of **Not Guilty** and request that I be placed on the docket. I understand that my appearance will be scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on the court date on my citation, unless otherwise notified. *A plea of Not Guilty and a request for an appearance before the judge must be submitted in writing to our office at least 7 days prior to the appearance date.*
