



MARINA BOAT RAMP & PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION

The City of Jamaica Beach Regatta Basin ("Marina") facility features a single, stabilized, paved boat ramp with finger piers, parking area and seating area (no restrooms). This private facility is for Jamaica Beach residents and their guest ONLY, requires a permit to launch, remove and/or park, and does not allow for any type of commercial use. Residency will be verified. Use this form to apply for an annual or daily permit for your household or authorized guest. Permits may be purchased in person at Jamaica Beach City Hall during business hours. Permit fees are subject to change per City Council approval.

Terms of Use:

Before purchasing a permit, please read and understand the terms of use listed below.

- Boat ramp and parking area is for residents only. All residents must purchase a permit before use.
- Residents may purchase a daily permit for the purpose of allowing a specific guest to use the boat ramp. Please note a daily permit is required for each day the ramp is used, not how long a watercraft is in the water. Resident is required to report guest info to City Hall prior to using the pre-purchased permit(s).
- Permit(s) may be purchased for vehicle or boat trailer.
- **Annual permits are \$25.00 each** and are valid for one year from the date purchased.
- **Daily permits are \$10.00 each** and are valid for one day ONLY (date indicated on the hanging placard).
- Permit must be visibly displayed in the following locations: Annual permit must be placed on the vehicle's front windshield or boat trailer's winch post; Daily permit must be hung on the vehicle's rearview mirror with the permit # and date facing the front windshield.
- NO commercial use. Permits will NOT be issued for commercial use of the boat ramp or parking area.
- Vehicles or trailers are not permitted to park at the Marina for more than (24) consecutive hours.
- Permit does not guarantee a parking space. Parking spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are intended for boats that are in use.
- Unattached trailer or recreational vehicle parking not allowed.
- Permit fees are non-refundable. Lost/stolen permits will not be reissued; new permit must be purchased.
- Permits are non-transferable. If a vehicle or trailer is changed during the permit year, remove the sticker from the existing vehicle/trailer and return it to City Hall. A new numbered replacement permit will be issued free of charge upon receipt of the old permit decal only.
- Violations of any of these terms may result in ticketing, towing at the owners expense, and/or revocation of permit per City Ordinance 2020-3.
- The City of Jamaica Beach has the right to close the boat ramp and/or parking area for good cause, including but not limited to maintenance and repairs or in the event of an emergency.

Hold Harmless/Indemnification Agreement:

I hereby assume the risk associated with the use of the Marina and agree to hold the City of Jamaica Beach, its agents, designees, employees, and elected officials free and harmless at all times from and against all claims, liability, expenses, losses, costs, fines, damages or causes of action of every kind and character, including attorney's fees and costs, whether at trial or appellate levels or otherwise, due to my acts, errors or omissions resulting in bodily injury, including death, or damage to my property or the property of others incident to or in connection with my use of the facility.

By signing, I hereby acknowledge that I have read and agree to abide by the terms, rules, regulations and laws governing the use of the Marina facility. I understand that failure to comply with these rules may result in a fine or civil penalty or the inability to obtain a boat ramp & parking permit.
