

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONDUCTING OF THE BUSINESS OF PEDDLING AND FOODHANDLING WITHIN CERTAIN SPECIFIED AREAS OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm corporation or other legal business entity to peddle, rent, lease, sell or offer for sale any goods, wares, merchandise, papers, magazines, drinks, confections, foods, articles of foods or services on any public streets, sidewalks, public beaches, private beaches, public buildings and/or private buildings and/or residences within the corporate limits of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas.

SECTION 2. Penalties for violations of the provision of this statute will be assessed under Ordinance 76-6 adopted by the Village of Jamaica Beach on April 1, 1976.

SECTION 3. That the hereinbefore recited ordinance be enacted as 76-~~19~~ of the ordinances of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
