

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP STREETS AND ONE WAY STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS: That based on a traffic investigation in the VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, stop streets and one way streets be established as provided for in this ordinance and penalties be set for violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 1. The word "vehicle" as used in this Ordinance, except where otherwise defined for purposes of certain provisions, shall mean every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person having possession of, or control of, or operating or driving any vehicle to cause or allow such vehicle to enter upon any of the following named streets at the indicated intersections without first causing such vehicle to come to a complete stop immediately before crossing the property line of the street to be entered:
Buccaneer Drive at its intersection with Henry Morgan Road
Buccaneer Drive at its intersection with Jolly Roger Road
Bob Smith Drive at its intersection with Jolly Roger Road
San Luis Pass Road at its intersection with Bob Smith Drive
San Luis Pass Road at its intersection with Beachcomber Drive
Bob Smith Drive at its intersection with Henry Morgan Road

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person having possession of, or control of, or operating or driving any vehicle to disobey the traffic signal at the intersection of Buccaneer Drive and San Luis Pass Road.

SECTION 4. The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as one way streets to be used by vehicles traveling only in the direction indicated and it shall be unlawful for any person in charge of or control of or operating or driving any vehicle to allow or cause the same to enter into, move upon or proceed along such streets or parts thereof other than in the direction indicated:
Buccaneer Drive from Captain Kidd Road to San Luis Pass Road in a southerly direction.
Buccaneer Drive from San Luis Pass Road to Captain Kidd Road in a northerly direction.

SECTION 5. Penalties for violations of the provisions of this statute will be assessed under Ordinance No. 76-6 adopted by the VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH on April 1, 1976.

SECTION 6. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be and become effective from



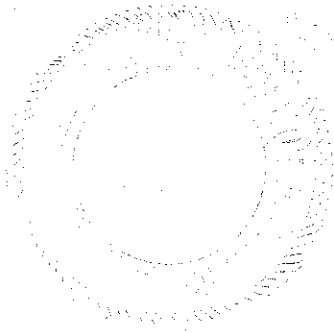
