

ORDINANCE 77-12

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING INTERFERENCE WITH ANY PEACE OFFICER IN THE LAWFUL DISCHARGE OF HIS DUTIES WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct, prevent, or interfere with or attempt to obstruct, prevent, or interfere with any person he knows to be a peace officer in the lawful discharge of his duty.


SECTION 2. Penalties for the violation of any act prohibited by this Ordinance will be assessed under Ordinance 76-6 as amended by Ordinance 77-1.

SECTION 3. That the hereinbefore recited ordinance be enacted as 77-12 of the Ordinances of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
