

ORDINANCE NO. 77-2

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD AT THE NEXT REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION SCHEDULED APRIL 2, 1977, ON THE ISSUE OF ADOPTION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX ACT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of February, 1977, there was presented to the Village Council a petition calling for the holding of an election on the issue of the adoption of the Local Sales and Use Tax Act for the benefit of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas; and

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of February, 1977, the Village Council determined that said petition was both executed by qualified voters of the Village of Jamaica Beach and that said qualified voters so executing the petition constituted at least twenty percent (20%) of the total number of votes cast in the last preceding regular Village election; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the terms and provisions of Article 1066c, V.A.T.S., an election needs be held on the issue of the adoption of the Local Sales and Use Tax Act for the benefit of the Village of Jamaica Beach;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That in accordance with Article 1066c, V.A.T.S. the scheduling of an election is hereby called to determine the issue of the adoption of the Local Sales and Use Tax for the benefit of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas.

SECTION 2. That said election is hereby scheduled to be held at the next Village election on April 2, 1977.

SECTION 3. That the ballot on the question of the adoption of said Local Sales and Use Tax Act at said election shall have printed on it the following:

"For adoption of a one percent (1%) Local Sales and Use Tax within the City".


"Against adoption of one percent (1%) Local Sales and Use Tax within the City".

SECTION 4. That the hearing before recited ordinance be enacted as 77-2, of the Ordinances of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
