

ORDINANCE 77-5

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF
A JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE VILLAGE
OF JAMAICA BEACH AND PROVIDING FOR SALARY AND
TERM OF OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Jamaica Beach deems it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village to provide for the appointment of a Municipal Judge for the Municipal Court of the Village of Jamaica Beach, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council feels that the appointment of James Foster as said Municipal Judge would be in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH:

SECTION 1. That the office of Judge of the Municipal Court of the Village of Jamaica Beach, shall be filled by appointment by the Village Council of the Village.

SECTION 2. That James Foster shall be and he is hereby appointed to be Judge of the Municipal Court of the Village.

SECTION 3. That James Foster shall serve as the Judge of said Municipal Court of the Village until April 4, 1978 or until his successor has been appointed and qualified.


SECTION 4. That beginning April 4, 1978, the term of office of the Judge of the Municipal Court of the Village shall be for a period of two years.


SECTION 5. That the Judge of the Municipal Court shall receive a salary of \$1.00 per year.
