

ORDINANCE 78-1

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF CITY MARSHALL AND CREATING THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF POLICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF JAMAICA BEACH TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the position of City Marshall shall be and is hereby abolished.


SECTION 2. That the Village Council shall be, and is hereby empowered to employ a Chief of Police, together with one or more police officers, to establish a salary for said position and to require giving of a bond in statutory form by the Chief of Police for the faithful performance of his duty.

SECTION 3. Ordinances or Report of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.


