

AN ORDINANCE RETAINING THE ONE PERCENT SALES TAX ON
RESIDENTIAL GAS AND ELECTRIC
SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF JAMACIA BEACH,
TEXAS:

That the one percent (1%) City tax on residential gas and electric bills be continued in force and effect and that the Comptroller of the State of Texas be notified by sending him a copy of this Ordinance, of the decision of this Council to continue said utility sales tax.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
