

ORDINANCE 78-5

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1978

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF JAMAICA BEACH,


TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That upon all personal, real and mixed property, owned and situated within the territorial limits of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas, on January 1, 1978 and not exempt from taxation by such Village under the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, there shall be and there are hereby levied for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1978, annual Ad Valorem taxes at the rate of One Dollar and twenty-one and one-half cents (\$1.21 $\frac{1}{2}$) upon each one hundred (\$100) dollars, 80% of valuation of such property for general purposes.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or reports of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be and become effective, from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
