

ORDINANCE NO. 79-2

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE BEACH
TO VEHICLER TRAFFIC


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF JAMACIA BEACH,
TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That from and after the date of adoption of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle as that term is defined by the Laws of the State of Texas on any portion of the beaches adjoining the Gulf of Mexico located within the City Limits of the Village of Jamacia Beach save and except in an area one hundred fifty feet from the center line of Bucaneer Drive in an easterly and westerly direction thereof extended to the mean high tide line of the Gulf of Mexico, and in an area of one hundred foot westerly from the State Park Road extended to the mean high tide line of the Gulf of Mexico.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective from ^{6⁰¹} ~~6:00~~ ^{12:00} o'clock A. M. each Saturday to 6:00 o'clock P. M. each Sunday and all legal holidays as defined by the Laws of the State of Texas beginning June 2, 1979, and ending September ¹⁵ 30, 1979.

SECTION 3. A violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars in an amount, on conviction thereof.
