

ORDINANCE 85-4

VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 80-1 CLOSING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE BEACH TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF:

PART A. Ordinance No. 80-1 is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That from and after the date of adoption of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle as that term is defined by the laws of the State of Texas on any portion of the beaches adjoining the Gulf of Mexico located within the City limits of the Village of Jamaica Beach save and except in an area one hundred fifty (150) feet from the center line of Buccaneer Drive in an easterly and westerly direction thereof extended to the mean high tide line of the Gulf of Mexico, and in an area of one hundred fifty (150) feet westerly from the State Park Road extended to the mean high tide line of the Gulf of Mexico.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. A violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed two hundred dollars (200.00) in an amount, on conviction thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after the date of its adoption and publication as required by law.
