

ORDINANCE 96-5A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS SETTING FORTH MAXIMUM RATES FOR RETAIL NATURAL GAS CONSUMPTION IN THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH; MAKING VARIOUS FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, by letter dated May 14, 1996, Southern Union Gas Company has requested certain changes in the rates it is authorized to charge local customers in Jamaica Beach; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Ordinance 91-3 granting a franchise to Southern Union Gas Company authorizes the Village of Jamaica Beach to grant such a decrease; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Jamaica Beach deems it in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Jamaica Beach to adopt such adjusted rates that will decrease Company revenues within Jamaica Beach of approximately \$235.00 or 3.65%;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS:

Section 1. That all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict only.

Section 2. The rate decrease approved in the Ordinance shall be effective from and after July 1, 1996, and this Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption.
