

ORDINANCE 96-6

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1996

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That upon all personal, real and mixed property, owned and situated within the territorial limits of the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas, on January 1, 1996 and not exempt from taxation by such Village under the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, there shall be and there are hereby levied for the Fiscal year beginning October 1, 1996, annual Ad Valorem taxes at the rate of sixty and sixty eight hundredth cents (\$0.6068) upon each one hundred (\$100) dollars, 100% of valuation of such property.

- A. For the maintenance, operation, and support of the general government (general fund) \$0.4273 on each \$100 valuation of property, and
- B. For the interest and sinking fund, \$0.1795 on each \$100 valuation of property.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be and become effective, from and after its adoption.
