

ORDINANCE 99-03-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-2 REGARDING THE APPOINTMENT OF
RESERVE POLICE OFFICERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS:

That Section 2 and 4 of Ordinance 98-2 are amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The Chief of Police and the City Administrator shall appoint members of the reserve police force.


Section 4. No person appointed to the reserve police force may carry or otherwise act as a peace officer unless he has been approved by the Chief of Police and the City Administrator, and Has fulfilled the minimum training standards described in Section 5 of Ordinance 98-2. The reserve candidate must complete a through background check prior to appointment. After a background check, approval and fulfillment of the minimum training standards, he may carry a weapon only when authorized by the Chief of Police, and when discharging official duties as a duly constituted peace officer.
