

ORDINANCE 2002-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 80-3 ADDING THE FOLLOWING, TO THE LIST OF PROHIBITED ANIMALS, REPTILES, FOWL, BIRDS, AND INSECTS THAT MAY BE KEPT ON ANY PREMISES IN THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH:

Additions to Section 1.

5. Livestock
6. Fowl
7. Bees
8. Birds of prey
9. Pot-Bellied Pigs (may be kept indoors only)
10. Ferrets (may be kept indoors only)

Additions to Section 2.

Livestock shall mean, but may not be limited to, all domesticated animals including but not limited to horses, mules, donkeys, cattle, goats, sheep, swine, miniature or Shetland ponies, and does not include dogs and cats.

Fowl shall mean a bird of any kind, including, but not limited to, chickens, geese, guineas, pigeons, emus, ostriches, rheas, turkeys and pheasants.

Birds of prey shall mean, but may not be limited to, condors, eagles, hawks, and falcons.

Pot Bellied Pigs shall mean a Vietnamese pig from Southeast Asia, a sub-species of the common pig.


Ferrets shall mean a domesticated animal related to the European polecat.

Bees mean any stage of the common domestic honeybee, *Apis mellifera* species.

The Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption
