

ORDINANCE 2009-3

**An Ordinance Levying Ad Valorem Taxes For
The Fiscal Year Beginning October 1, 2009**

Be it ordained by the City Council of Jamaica Beach, Texas:

Section 1. That upon all personal, real, and mixed property, owned and situated within the territorial limits of the City of Jamaica Beach, Texas, on January 1, 2009, and not exempt from taxation by such City under the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, there shall be and there is hereby levied for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2009, annual Ad Valorem taxes at the rate of \$0.3228 upon each \$100 dollars, 100% of valuation of such property, for the maintenance, operation, and support of the general government (general fund).

Section 2. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's rate. The tax rate will effectively be raised by 7.95 percent and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$23.77.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be and become effective, from and after its adoption.
