Dear Resident/Property Owner:

This notice is being provided to you as a courtesy to inform you about various street reconstruction and asphalt overlay projects that will be undertaken by the City during the next 18 months. The Street Improvement Program is scheduled to begin in November of 2019 and be completed by mid-May 2021.

In April 2019, City Council approved an interlocal agreement with Galveston County to provide various roadway improvements throughout our community. Galveston County recently signed engineering contracts with McDonough Engineering to facilitate the Street Improvement Program. Below is the tentative project schedule:

- Surveying and Geotextile Soil Borings: Nov 15, 2019-Jan 10, 2020
- Preliminary Engineering: Jan 11, 2020-May-15, 2020
- Final Engineering: May 16, 2020-Jul 1, 2020
- Bidding Award: Jul 2, 2020-Nov 1, 2020
- **Construction Phase: Nov 2, 2020-May 5, 2021**

- Buccaneer Dr. from Jamaica Beach Rd. to Beach entrance - Reconstruction
- Pelican Rd. – Reconstruction
- Beachcomber Dr. – Reconstruction
- Jamaica Inn from Buccaneer Rd. to Marina - Asphalt Reclamation
- 16600 Block of Lewis Scott Rd. – Asphalt Reclamation
- Bahama Way – Mill & Overlay
- Bermuda Way – Mill & Overlay - Raise asphalt approach to Jamaica Cove
- 16600 Block of John Silver – Raise asphalt 6 inches
- Anchor Way from Jolly Roger to Bayside Way – Mill & Overlay
- 16500 Block of Blackbeard Rd. – Mill & Overlay
- 16500 Block of Lewis Scott – Mill & Overlay
- Nassau Way – Mill & Overlay
- Tortuga Way from Spanish Way to Karankawa – Mill & Overlay
- Albatross Rd – Mill & Overlay

You can expect to see surveying vehicles from Costello Surveying and soil boring equipment from Geotest Engineering traveling throughout our community during the next 2-3 months gathering data for preliminary engineering purposes. This preliminary work will not cause any traffic disruptions or lengthy road closures.

Construction alert letters will be sent to each resident/property owner impacted by the projects listed in the Street Improvement Program sometime in June or July of 2020.
